financial applications, including general ledger, payables, receivables and cash management. The package also tracks members, dues, invoices, and charges to specific account centers.

AR’s clients can access financial data over the Internet through MAS 500’s eExecutive module, which consolidates critical information into a compact executive portal. Day or night, from any location in the world, a click of the mouse summons detailed information on expenditures. Since some of AR’s client organizations have officers in South America, Europe and Asia, this feature is a great convenience. It also allows the Brussels office to maintain the same information.

“An organization’s treasurer can do research on a real-time basis,” Wall reports, “drilling down to get the exact figures they need without a telephone call to the association office. Before, this data was historical, and it could be a month old before clients saw it. Now they can have up-to-date details on printing, mailing and labeling costs, for example. This is invaluable, because the more they know about operations, the less risk they incur — and the better they can run their association.”

### **Power with Project Accounting and eTimesheets**

AR’s legacy time system allocated

employee hours to clients, but did not integrate with the financial package for invoicing and project tracking. MAS 500’s Project Accounting and eTimesheets modules, however, give AR a seamless system where data is entered only once, for better client accountability and improved efficiencies.

“The modules give us a browser-based means for staff to record their time,” says Wall. “Employees enter hours to be charged to a project, and they’re automatically posted for invoicing. This allows us to be very granular when we break out charges to clients.”

The Project Accounting module also allocates expenses by event. “Associations can compare costs at different conferences and make more informed decisions about future events,” Wall notes.
